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The story behind this work:

Transportation Transformation was born out of a challenge, posed by the NY Opera Alliance and NY Public Radio – The Greene Space, to nine opera professionals who chose to accept the mission of creating an original 10-minute opera within 24-hours. They were given a prompt at 7am Friday morning April 12th to create an opera set in a New York City subway car. The team selected duets from Mozart's operatic line-up and set to work creating a pastiche with an original libretto. The work was performed before a live audience at 1pm Saturday April 13th at The Greene Space and simultaneously streamed live on Facebook.

Synopsis:

It is Monday morning on the F train platform. It is March. The weather is dreary.

Four individuals board the train that then comes to a sudden halt. They review their day-to-day existence in varying modes of despair and frustration at the delay they are in. Typical MTA!

The F train is now skipping stops and, in a moment of magical realism, bursts forth out of the tunnel to lift off of its tracks and fly through the air carrying the four passengers over their homeland of Brooklyn. All four face the reality of who they are and what their life is about. Here, on a flying F train, they discover friendship, make connections and help one another.

Everyone decides to ride the train to a beautiful spot in the center of Manhattan and spend the day together. Nobody dies in this operal:)

Characters:

Leslie – (Danielle Buonaiuto) A hard-driving, type-A individual who's only desire is to master the universe from her iPhone and stomp on people who get in her way.

Ava – (La Toya Lewis) A good religious woman with an authentic spirit and desire to help people find themselves. She can be—at times—a little too zealous, though.

Melanie – (Melissa Serluco) A native New Yorker, now a homeless poet who rides the train for warmth and inspiration for her words. This morning she has a problem…her pencil is broken.

Mark – (Brian Alvarado) A transplant from Wisconsin, Brian has been in NY for a year working IT for a bank and he has yet to find any friends. He is lonely and has lost his inherent spark.

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As the music begins, all four characters walk onto the stage and take their place around the subway platform bench, waiting for the train to arrive.

Music indicates the arriving train and the performers adjust the chairs into a configuration as would be found in the car of a typical F train. They take their places.
